Holy Seven Youths ("Seven Sleepers") of Ephesus

"Lord I Call..." Tone 5

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my prayer arise in Your sight as incense, and let the lifting up of my hands be an evening sacrifice!//
Hear me, O Lord!

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!

Tone 5 (for the Resurrection)

By Your <u>pre</u>cious <u>Cross</u>, O Christ, You have put the <u>dev</u>il to shame. By Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion, You have blunted the <u>sting</u> of sin and <u>saved</u> us from the <u>gates</u> of death.// We glorify You, O <u>on</u>ly begotten One.

V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.

<u>Christ</u> was led as a sheep to the <u>slaughter</u> in order to grant Resurrection to the <u>human race</u>. The <u>princes</u> of hell were <u>fright</u>ened by this, for the <u>gates</u> of sorrow were <u>lift</u>ed. Christ the King of glory had <u>en</u>tered,

saying to those in chains: "Go forth!"//

And to those in <u>darkness</u>: "Come to the light!"

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

O great wonder!

The Creator of the invisible suffered in the flesh in His <u>love</u> for man and <u>rose</u> again im<u>mor</u>tal.

Come, O sons of nations,

let us worship Him,

for delivered from error by His compassion,//

we have learned to sing of one <u>God</u> in three <u>Per</u>sons!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

(Resurrection stichera by Anatolius)

We <u>of</u>fer You our evening <u>wor</u>ship,
O never <u>set</u>ting Light,
Who <u>came</u> in these last days to the <u>world</u> in the flesh;
Who <u>ev</u>en descended to hell to dispel its <u>dark</u>ness.
Who has revealed the light of Resurrection to the <u>na</u>tions.//
Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Giv</u>er of light!

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

We <u>glo</u>rify the Leader of our sal<u>va</u>tion; by His Resur<u>rec</u>tion from the dead, the <u>world</u> was <u>saved</u> from deceit. The as<u>sem</u>bly of Angels rejoices as the deceit of demons is <u>ov</u>erthrown.// Fallen Adam <u>ris</u>es as the <u>dev</u>il falls.

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

The <u>guards</u> were instructed by the <u>law</u>less ones:

"Hide the rising of Christ, take <u>mon</u>ey and say:

'The <u>body</u> was stolen from the tomb while <u>we</u> were asleep.'"

But <u>who</u> has heard of a body being <u>sto</u>len,
a body embalmed and <u>na</u>ked,
with its <u>grave</u> clothes left be<u>hind</u> in the tomb?

Do <u>not</u> be de<u>ceived</u>, O Jews,
study the words of the Prophets and <u>un</u>derstand://
Christ is the Redeemer of the <u>world</u> and all <u>pow</u>erful!

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord!

O <u>Lord</u>, Who has <u>cap</u>tured hell and <u>trampled</u> on death, You have en<u>light</u>ened the world by Your <u>prec</u>ious Cross.// O <u>Sav</u>ior, have <u>mer</u>cy on us!

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities.

Tone 1 (for the Holy Youths) (Joy of the Heavenly Hosts)

<u>Come</u>, let us ever sing hymns to the memory of the seven <u>hon</u>ored youths; the brilliant seven-branched <u>lamp</u>stand!

Let us cry <u>out</u> to Christ Who has <u>crowned</u> them://

"By their prayers, O Lord and Deliverer, bring <u>peace</u> to our life!"

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

The <u>sev</u>en godly youths died according to <u>na</u>ture.

Yet they rose up at once as <u>though</u> from sleep,
in a <u>man</u>ner transcending <u>na</u>ture indeed//
for they had slept in the cave as dead for three hundred and seventy-<u>two</u> years.

V. **(1)** For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Now let us honor John and Martínian, Anthony and Dionýsius with the godly Iámblicus and Maximílian, for they pray on our behalf! Together with them let us praise with devotion// the wise Exacustódian!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 5 (*Theotokion – Dogmatikon*)

In the Red Sea of old, a type of the Virgin Bride was prefigured. There Moses divided the waters; here Gabriel assisted in the miracle. There Israel crossed the sea without getting wet, here the Virgin gave birth to Christ without seed. After Israel's passage, the sea remained impassable; after Emmanuel's birth, the Virgin remained a Virgin. O ever-existing God Who appeared as Man,// O Lord, have mercy on us!

Aposticha

Tone 5 *(for the Resurrection)*

We <u>magnify</u> You in <u>songs</u> of praise,
O incarnate Christ and <u>Sav</u>ior.
By ac<u>cepting</u> the Cross and <u>death</u> for our sake,
as the <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of man,
You overthrew the <u>gates</u> of hell,//
and arose on the <u>third</u> day, <u>sav</u>ing our souls.

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

By being <u>pierced</u> in the side, O <u>Lov</u>er of man, You have poured out drops of life and sal<u>va</u>tion for all. By ac<u>cepting</u> death in the flesh, You have granted us immor<u>tal</u>ity. You have <u>freed</u> us by being <u>placed</u> in the tomb, and have resurrected us with Yourself in <u>glo</u>ry, as God.// Glory to You, O <u>Lord</u> and <u>Lov</u>er of man!

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

Your cruci<u>fix</u>ion and descent into hell are awesome, O <u>Lov</u>er of man. You have captured it, releasing the ancient <u>pris</u>oners. You have <u>opened Paradise</u> and <u>giv</u>en it to us. <u>Grant</u> us purification of sins, who glorify Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day! Make us <u>wor</u>thy of <u>Paradise</u>// and <u>save</u> us, O <u>Lov</u>er of man!

V. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

For our <u>sake</u>, You accepted <u>death</u> in the flesh, to rise from the dead on the <u>third</u> day. <u>Heal</u> us from our earthly <u>passions</u>, and re<u>store</u> us from our evil trans<u>gres</u>sions;//

and save us, O Lover of man!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 5 (*Theotokion*)

O most <u>pre</u>cious <u>Virgin</u>, you are the gate, the <u>tem</u>ple, the <u>pal</u>ace, the <u>throne</u> of the King.

From <u>you</u>, my Redeemer, <u>Christ</u> the Lord, appeared to those asleep in <u>dark</u>ness.

<u>He</u> is the Sun of <u>Right</u>eousness,

Who de<u>sired</u> to enlighten His image, whom He had created.

Since you possess motherly boldness before Him, O all praised <u>La</u>dy,// pray un<u>ceasingly</u> that our <u>souls</u> may be saved!

(at Great Vespers)

Tone 5 Troparion (Resurrection)

Let <u>us</u>, the faithful, praise and <u>wor</u>ship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the <u>Spir</u>it, <u>born</u> for our salvation from the <u>Virgin</u>; for He <u>willed</u> to be lifted up on the <u>Cross</u> in the flesh, to en<u>dure</u> death, and to <u>raise</u> the dead// by His <u>glorious</u> Resur<u>rec</u>tion.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit,

Tone 4 Troparion (Holy Youths)

Your seven holy <u>mar</u>tyrs, O Lord, through their sufferings have received incorruptible crowns from <u>You</u>, our God. For having Your strength, they laid low their <u>ad</u>versaries, and shattered the powerless boldness of <u>de</u>mons.//

Through their intercession, <u>save</u> our souls!

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 4 Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion

The mystery of all eternity, unknown even by Angels, through you, Theotokos, is revealed to those on earth: God incarnate by union without confusion. He voluntarily accepted the Cross for us, by which He resurrected the first-created man,// saving our souls from death.

(at Vigil)

Tone 4 Troparion to the Theotokos

Rejoice, O Virgin Theo<u>to</u>kos,
Mary, full of grace, the <u>Lord</u> is with you!
Blessed are you among <u>wo</u>men,
and blessed is the <u>Fruit</u> of your womb,//
for you have borne the <u>Sav</u>ior of our souls. (*thrice*)

(at the Divine Liturgy)

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Tone 5 Kontakion (*Resurrection*)

You de<u>scend</u>ed into hell, O my <u>Sav</u>ior, shattering its gates as Al<u>mighty</u>, resur<u>rec</u>ting the dead as Creator, and de<u>stroy</u>ing the <u>sting</u> of death.
You have delivered Adam from the curse, O <u>Lov</u>er of man,// and we cry to You: "O <u>Lord</u>, <u>save</u> us!"

Tone 4 Kontakion (Holy Youths)

The Seven Holy Youths renounced the perishing <u>comforts</u> of this world, preferring the eternal things of <u>Heaven</u>.

They were incorrupt after death and <u>rose</u> from the dead and buried the snares of the <u>devils!//</u>
O faithful, let us then honor them, singing a hymn of <u>praise</u> to Christ!

Tone 5 Prokeimenon (Resurrection)

You, O Lord, shall protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever. (*Ps. 11:7*)

V. Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly! (Ps. 11:1a)
